Study participants were asked to provide quantitative and qualitative evaluations of their asset management and investment consulting providers, including qualitative assessments of those firms soliciting their business and detailed information on important market trends. 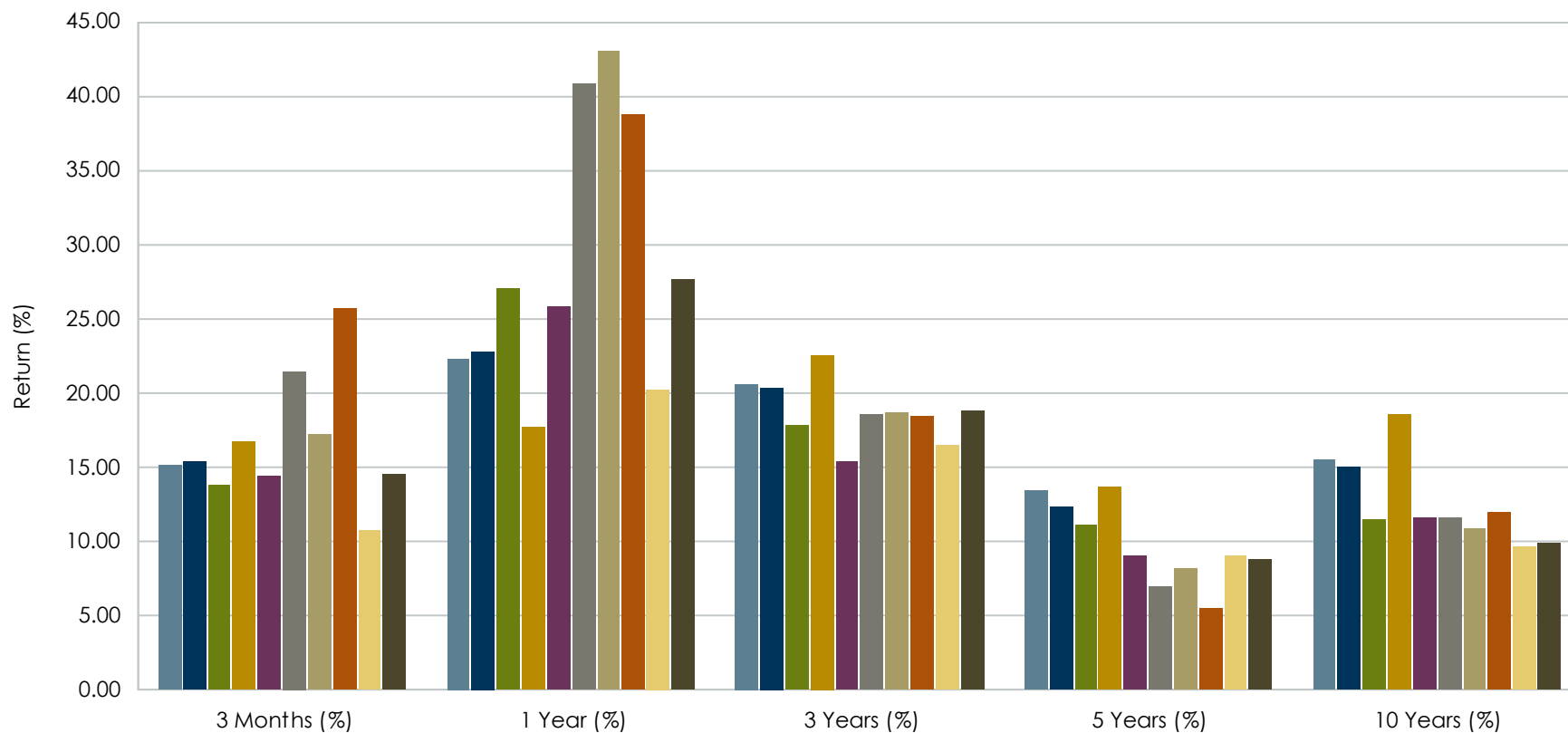

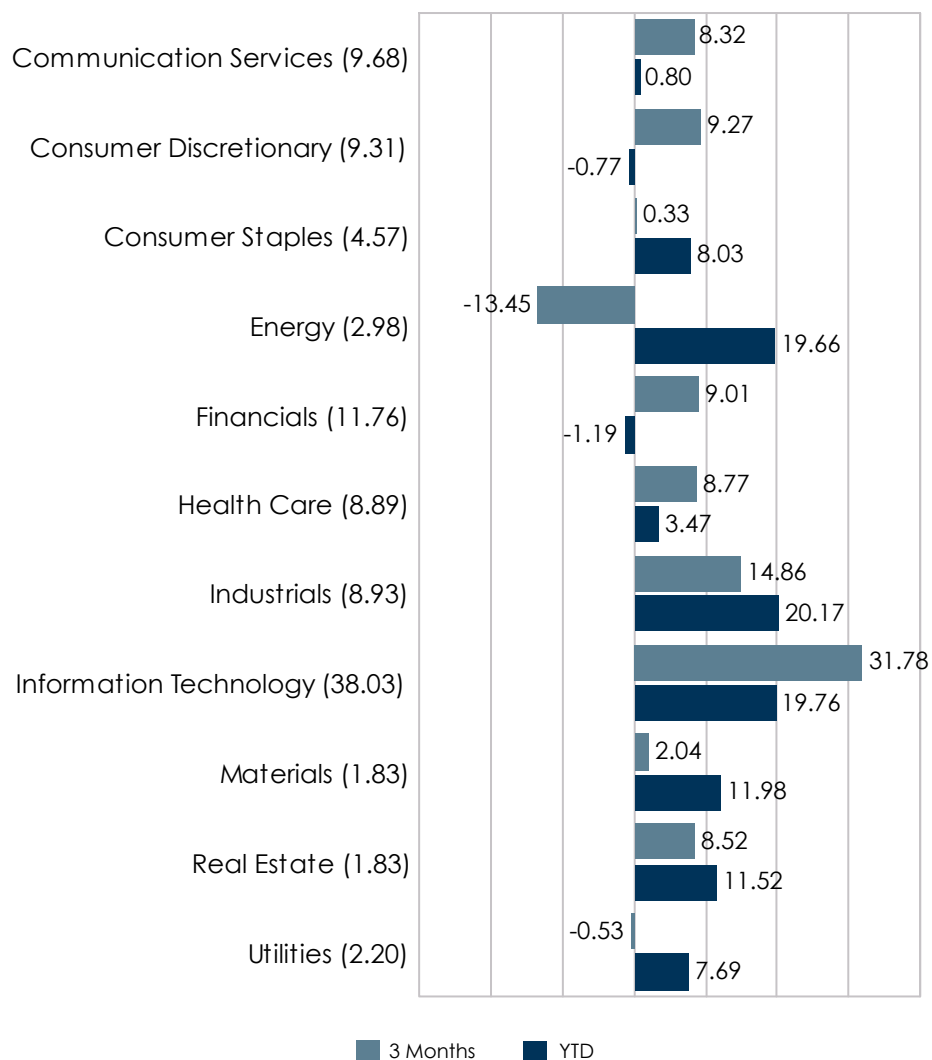

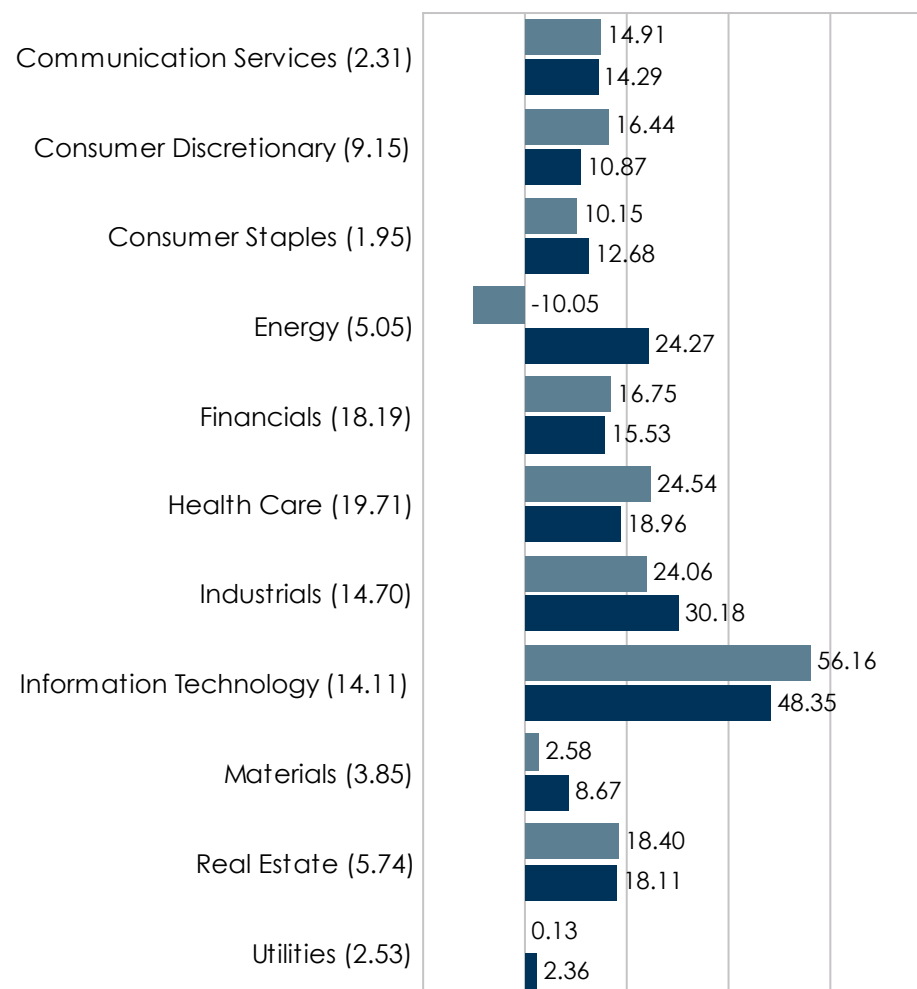
US Markets - Performance Breakdown

Russell 2000 - Sector Returns (%)



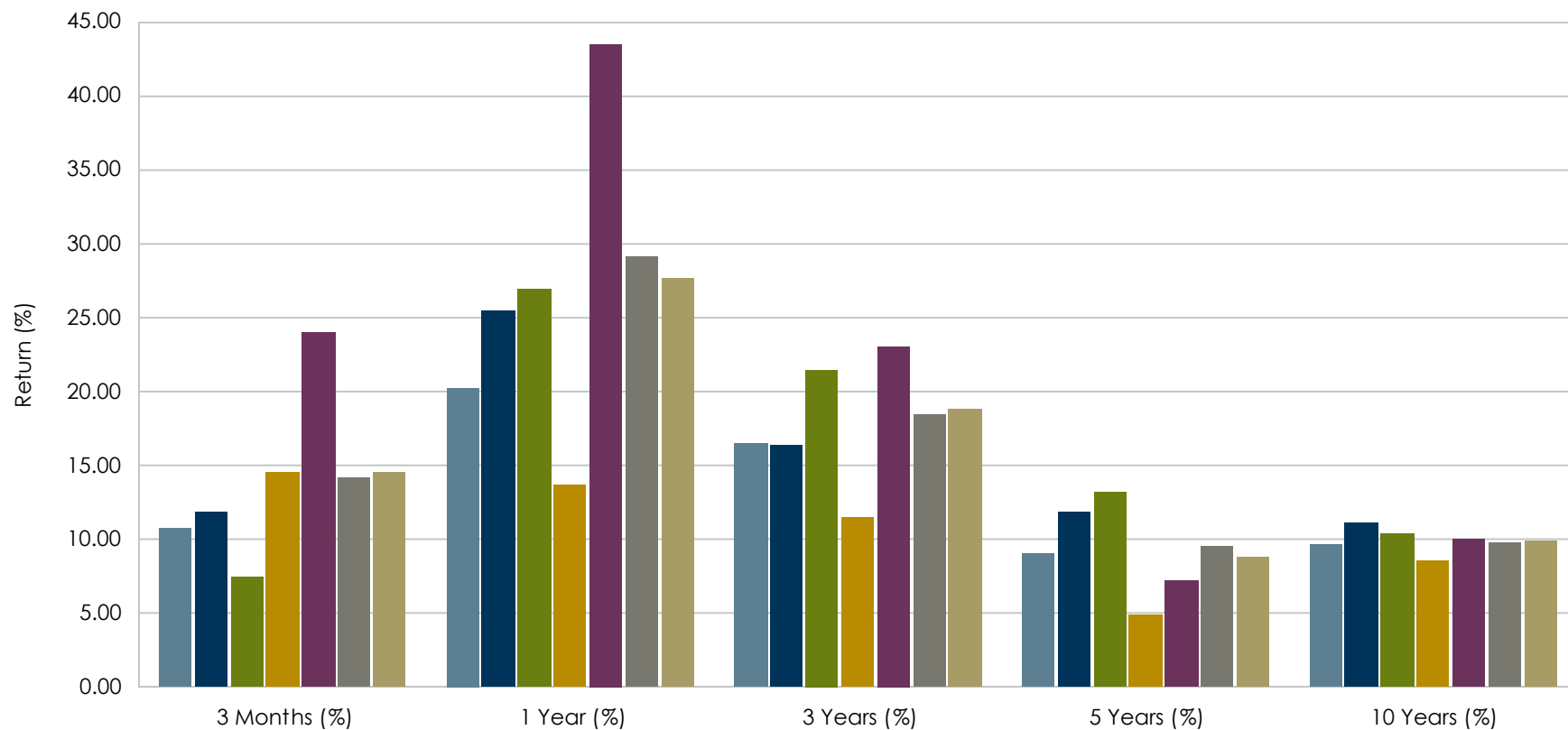

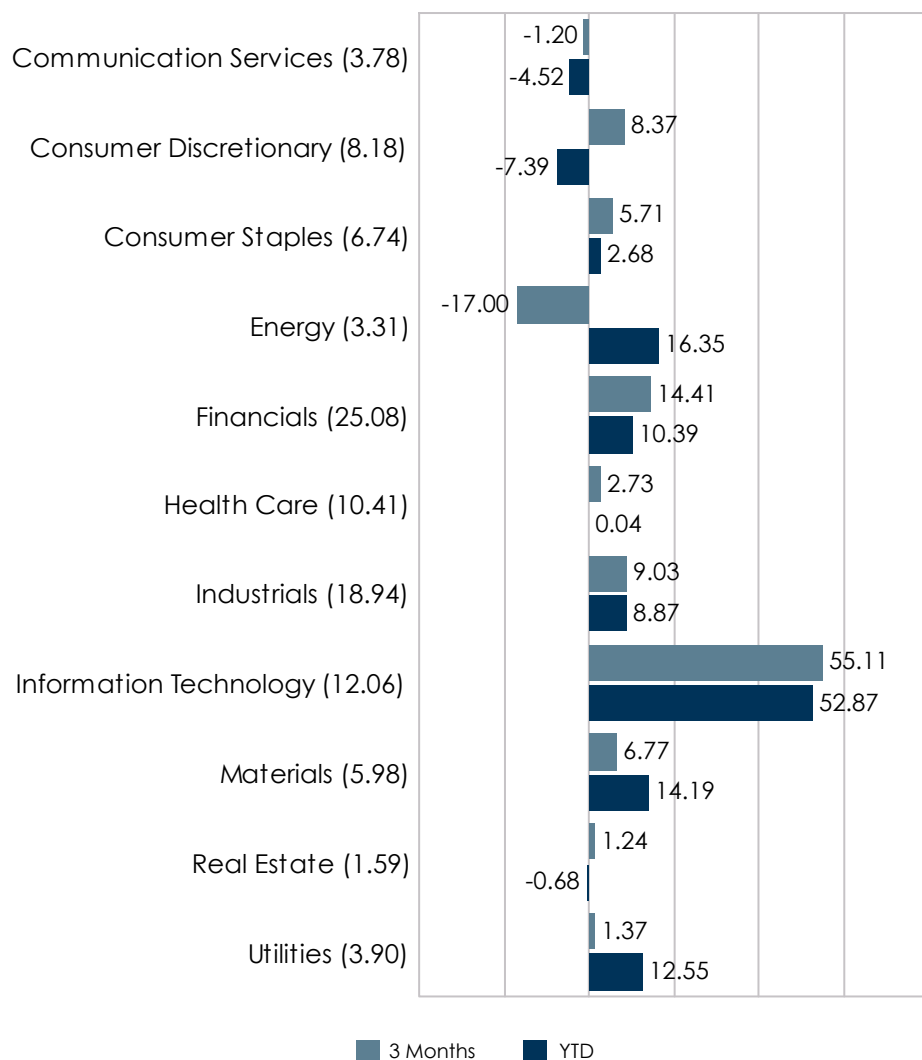

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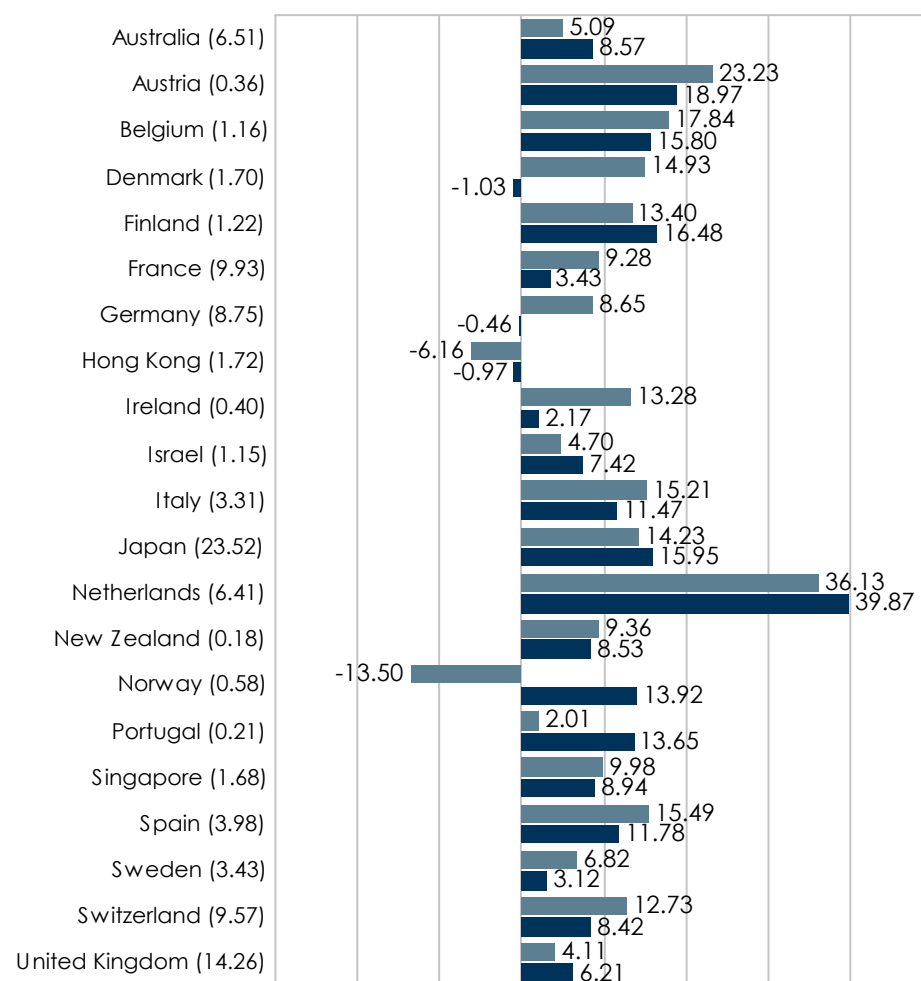
Non-US Equity - Performance Breakdown

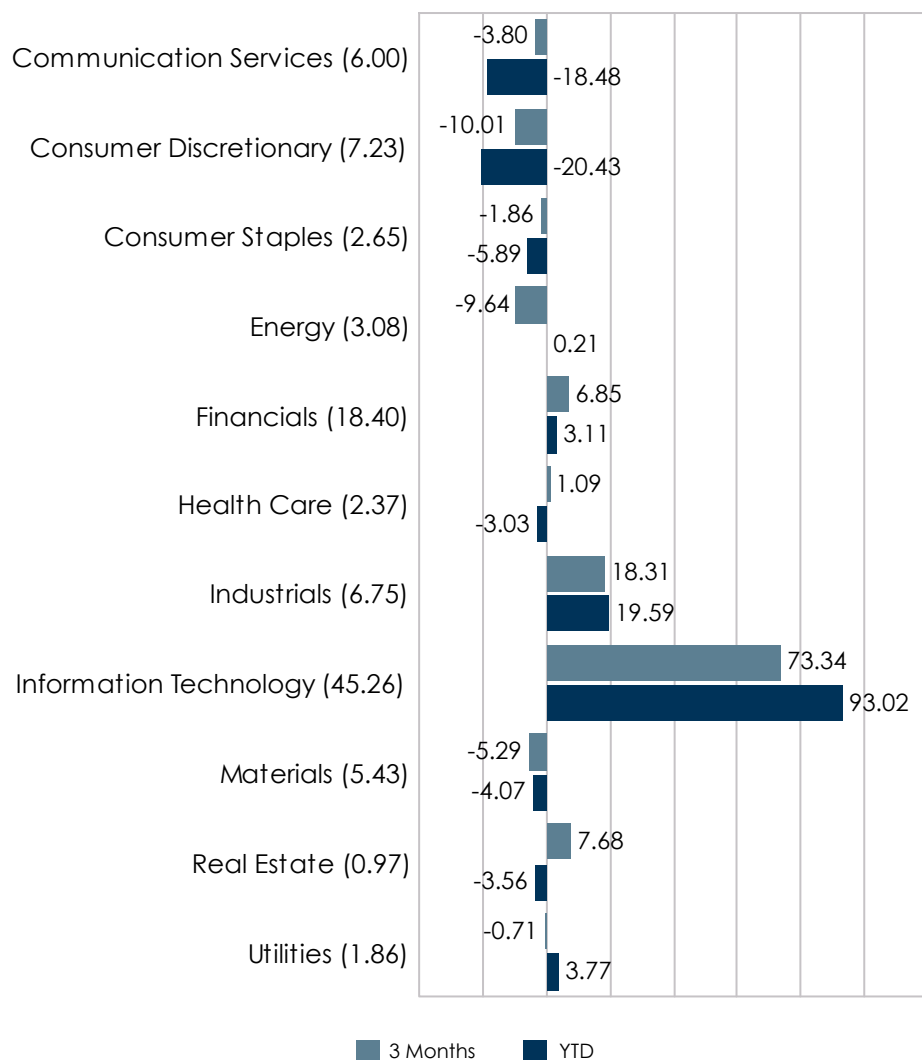

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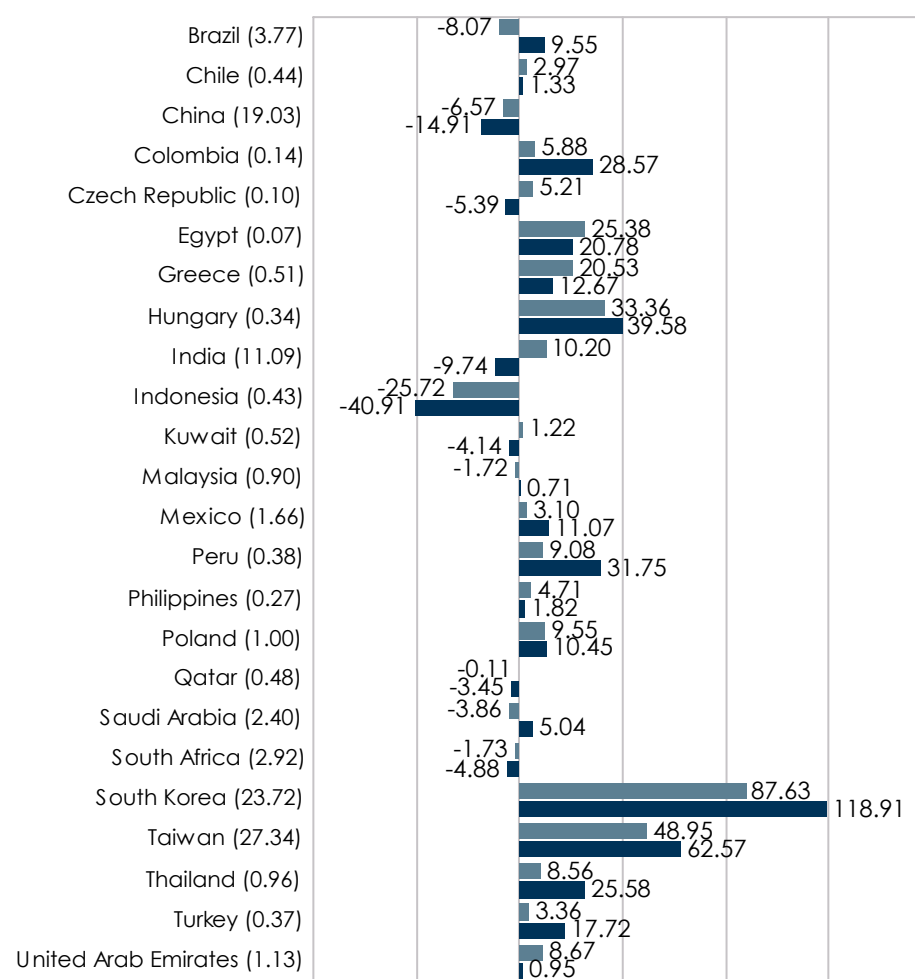
Emerging Markets - Performance Breakdown

MSCI Emerging Markets - Country Returns (%)



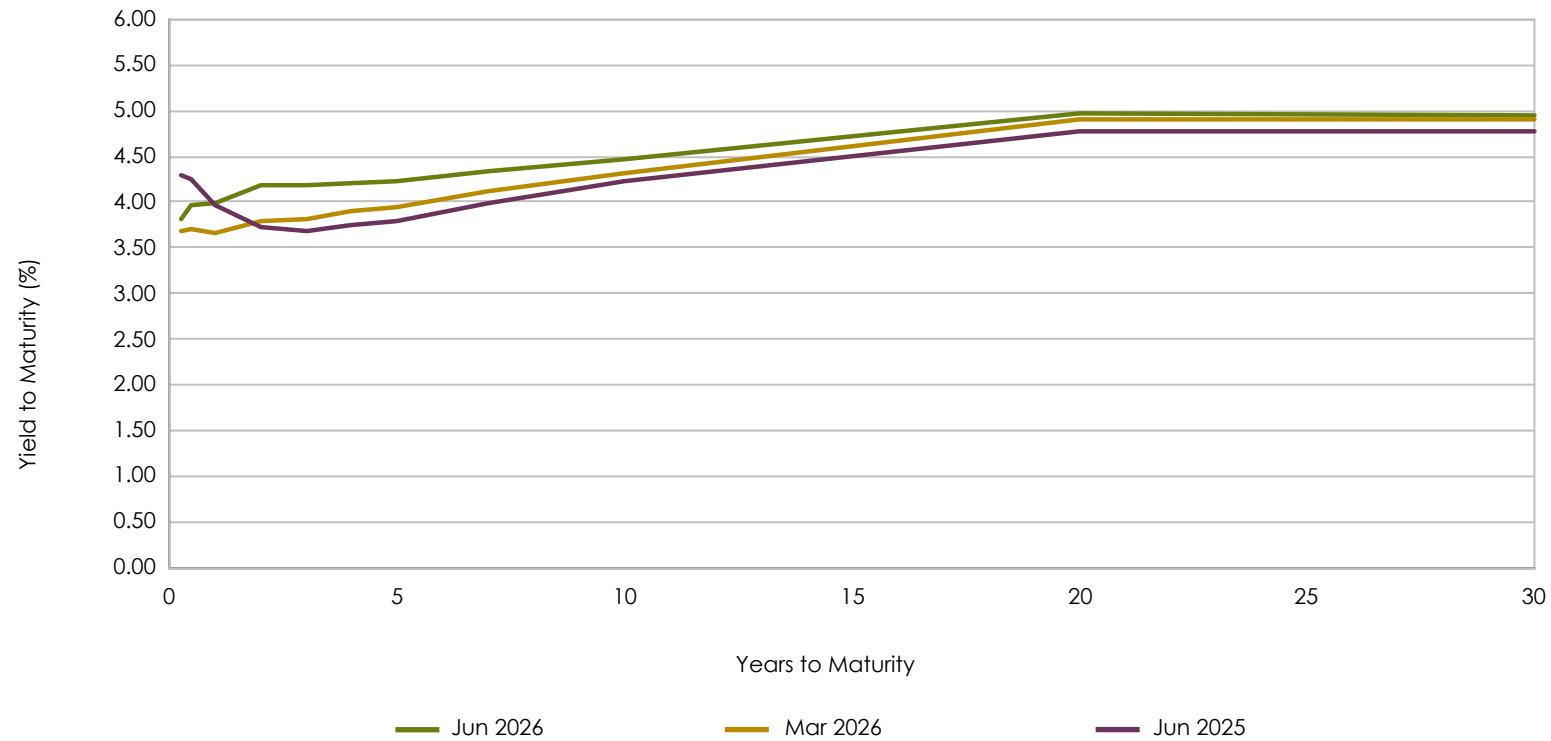

Government Issues - 3 Months to 30 Years Maturity

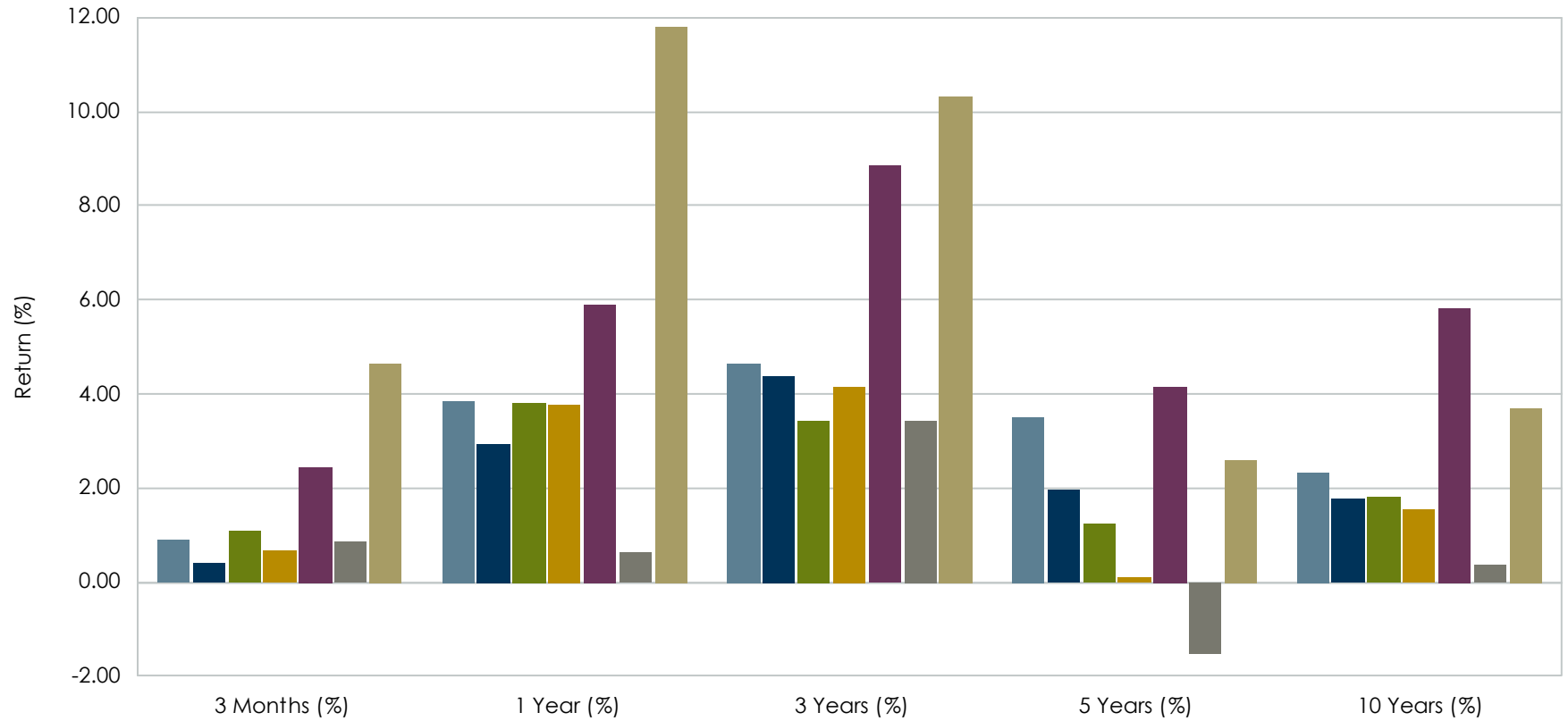

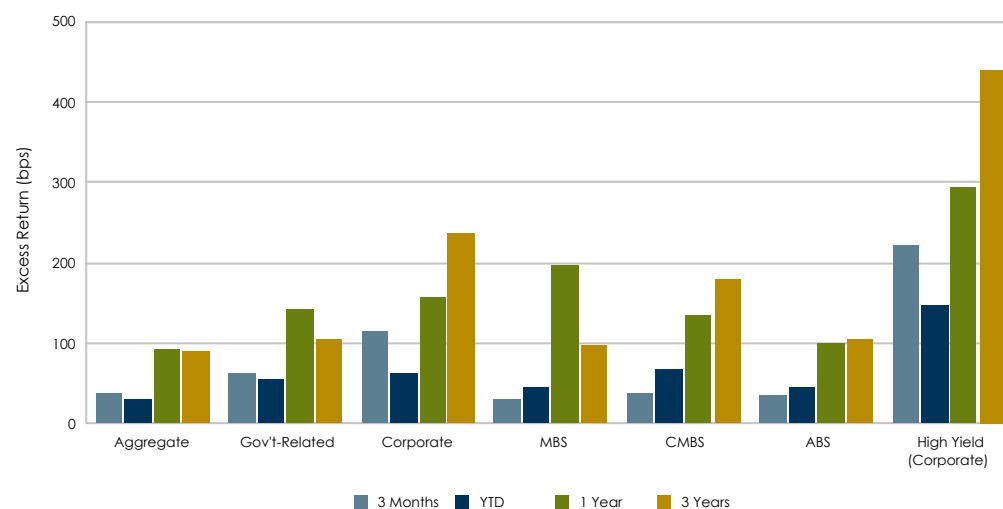

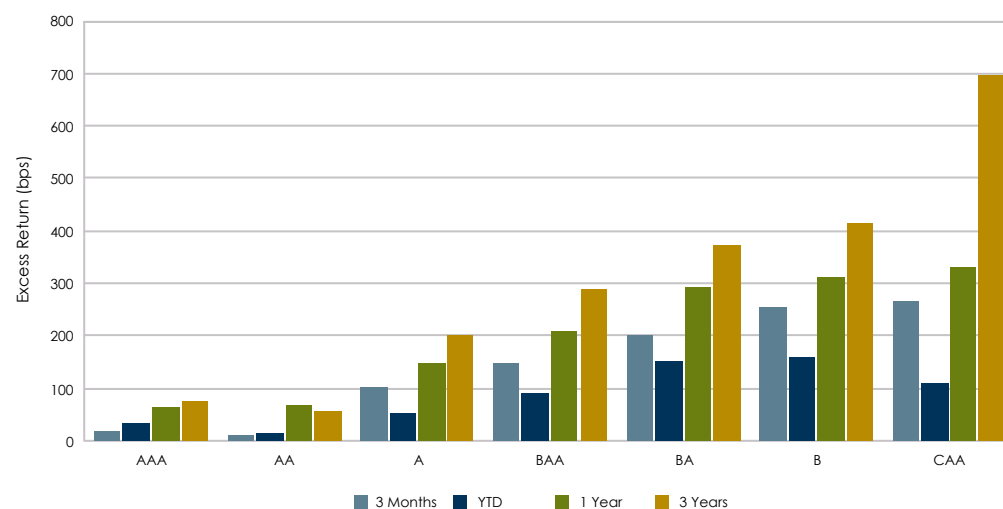

Vanguard Windsor II (VWNAX) – Page 38

This large cap value-oriented equity fund searches for low priced, high dividend paying stocks and is implemented through a strong cadre of capable managers, including Aristotle Capital Management, Hotchkis and Wiley, Sanders Capital, and Harris Associates. Harris Associates replaced Lazard in 4Q25. This fund outpaced the Russell 1000 Value by 156 basis points on average annually and ranks in the top 13th percentile relative to its peer group of large cap value managers over the past 10 years.

Vanguard FTSE Social Index (VFTAX) – Page 40

This fund was added to the fund lineup in May 2019 to allow participants to invest in a socially-conscious manner. This passively managed fund uses a screened index to eliminate companies that do not meet certain environmental, social and corporate governance criteria. This fund has posted strong absolute returns over the past 10 years, rising 16.06%, outpacing the Russell 1000 Index and ranking in the top 7th percentile of its peer group of large cap equity managers.

Vanguard Institutional Index (VINIX) – Page 42

This passively-managed fund is focused on providing performance in line with the broad large cap domestic equity market as measured by the S&P 500 Index, with a similar risk profile and very efficient fee structure. This fund has matched the risk-return profile of the S&P 500 over all time periods.

Vanguard PRIMECAP (VPMAX) – Page 44

This fund is tasked with providing excess returns in the large cap growth equity segment of the domestic market, as a complement to a similar value option within the plan. This fund posted strong results in the second quarter, outpacing the Russell 1000 Growth benchmark by 1,748 basis points and ranking in the top 2nd percentile of its peer group of large cap growth managers. This fund has performed in line with the benchmark over the past 10 years, up 18.56%, with significantly less volatility and ranking in the top 14th percentile of its peer group.

EV Atlanta Capital SMID (ERASX) – Page 46

This actively managed fund focuses on identifying seasoned, high quality small-to-mid capitalization U.S. companies with solid balance sheets and experienced management teams. This fund has continued to face headwinds in the second quarter as lower quality factors like high beta, smaller size, and companies with negative earnings continue to drive small caps. Despite the near term struggles, this fund has achieved an average annual return of 9.69% over the past 10 years.

Vanguard Small Cap Index (VSMAX) – Page 48

This fund is focused on providing performance in line with the small cap domestic equity market as measured by the CRSP US Small Cap Index, with a similar risk profile and very efficient fee structure. Over the last 10 years, this fund has performed in line with the benchmark, and ranks in the top 32nd percentile of its peer group.

Vanguard Total International Stock Index (VTIAX) – Page 50

This fund is focused on providing performance in line with the broad international equity market as measured by the FTSE Global All Cap Ex-US Index, with a similar risk profile and very efficient fee structure. This fund has performed in line with the benchmark on a risk adjusted basis over the last 10 years.

Vanguard All World ex-US Small Cap (VFSAX) – Page 52

This fund was added to the fund lineup in May 2019 to provide low-cost exposure to small capitalization companies located in non-U.S. developed markets. This fund is subject to currency risk and country risk and may experience heightened volatility because of its focus on small cap stocks. This fund has achieved strong absolute results over the past year, rising 18.61%, and ranked in the top 45th percentile of its peer group of international small/mid cap equity. While this fund has trailed the benchmark, this fund has achieved an 8.17% return on average annually over the past 10 years.

Vanguard Emerging Markets Stock Index (VEMAX) – Page 54

This fund was added to the fund lineup in May 2019. This fund employs an indexing investment approach to give investors a low cost exposure to emerging markets countries. This fund serves as an opportunity for investors to diversify their exposure to the international markets. This fund has achieved strong absolute returns over the past year, rising 24.00%.

Vanguard Intermediate Investment Grade Fund (VFIDX) – Page 56

This actively managed fund was added to the fund lineup in May 2019. It seeks to provide a moderate and sustainable level of current income by providing diversified exposure to medium and high quality investment grade bonds with a dollar-weighted average maturity of 5-10 years. This fund has matched the Bloomberg US Credit Intermediate benchmark over the last 10 years and ranks in the top 3rd percentile of its peer group of intermediate core bond managers.

Vanguard Total Bond Market Index (VBTLX) – Page 58

This fund has the objective of providing performance in line with the broad domestic bond markets as measured by the Bloomberg Aggregate Index, with a similar risk profile and very efficient fee structure. This fund has performed in line with the risk-return profile of the benchmark over the past 10 years.

Vanguard Retirement Savings Trust – Page 60

This fund seeks to provide a high level of current and stable income by investing in synthetic investment contracts backed by high-quality fixed income investments and traditional investments issued by insurance companies and banks, with a goal of maintaining a net asset value of \$1 per share.

Vanguard Total International Bond Index (VTABX) – Page 61

This fund was added to the fund lineup in May 2019. It seeks to provide broad exposure to non-US investment-grade bonds and serves as a complement to the other US fixed income options in the lineup. This fund is exposed to country/regional risk but utilizes currency hedging strategies to limit exchange rate risk. While slightly behind objectives, this fund has achieved a 4.27% average annual return over the past 3 years.

Vanguard Federal Money Market (VMFXX) – Page 63

This fund seeks a high level of current income by investing in high-quality money market instruments, with an average maturity of 90 days or less and a goal of maintaining a net asset value of \$1 per share.

Vanguard REIT Index (VGSLX) – Page 64

This fund is designed to track the performance of the domestic real estate investment trust (REIT) market. The fund has modestly trailed the FTSE NAREIT Index on a risk-adjusted basis over the past 10 years.

Vanguard Wellington (VWENX) – Page 66

This balanced equity and fixed income fund has a long history of outperforming objectives. The bond portfolio typically emphasizes high quality issues, while the equity portfolio focuses on dividend-paying companies with modest valuations. The mix between stocks and bonds can change over time depending on the manager's view of opportunities in the marketplace, with the current allocation at 66% stocks and 34% cash/bonds. 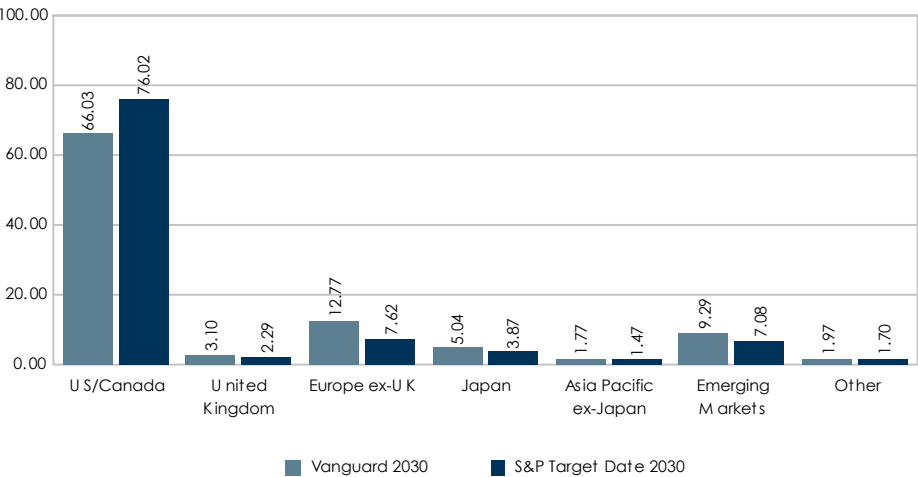
Asset Allocation Fund Type

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Definitions

Definitions of Statistical Measures

Alpha - the annualized difference between the manager's actual return and the manager's expected return given its relative risk vs. the benchmark (which is represented by beta, a measure that tracks volatility to an index).

Batting Average - a measure used to quantify a manager's ability to meet or beat a benchmark. A manager who outperforms the benchmark 20 out of a possible 40 times has a batting average of 50.

Beta - measures the portfolio's sensitivity of returns to market movements represented by the primary benchmark.

Down Capture - demonstrates the ratio of the portfolio's average returns relative to the benchmark in periods in which the benchmark had a negative return. For instance, a down-capture of 96% indicates that, on average, the portfolio is down 96% when the benchmark is down 100%. Lower portfolio down-capture is preferred.

R Squared - the amount of the manager's return that can be explained by the benchmark. A R Squared of 100 indicates a perfect correlation, while a R Squared of 0 indicates no correlation at all.

Sharpe Ratio - a measure of return per unit of risk. Higher sharpe ratios are preferred while negative ratios are generally meaningless and cannot be used for comparison purposes.

Standard Deviation - a measure of the portfolio's volatility. A large standard deviation relative to the benchmark represents volatile portfolio returns.

Tracking Error - a measure that reports the difference between the return of a manager that is received and that of a benchmark that the manager is attempting to track.

Up Capture - demonstrates the ratio of the portfolio's average returns relative to the benchmark in periods in which the benchmark had a positive return. For instance, an up-capture of 96% indicates that, on average, the portfolio is up 96% when the benchmark is up 100%. Higher portfolio up-capture is preferred.

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
